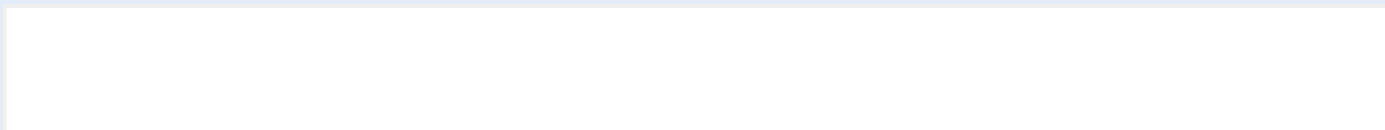
Directions
